AB 1826 Mandatory Organics Recycling

By the numbers. For BUSINESSES and MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENCES WITH 5 OR MORE UNITS:

JANUARY 1, 2016

MANDATORY ORGANICS RECYCLING PROGRAM* IMPLEMENTED. **APRIL 1, 2016**



JANUARY 1, 2017



JANUARY 1, 2019



SUMMER/FALL 2021



*This law requires that on and after January 1, 2016, local jurisdictions across the state **implement an organic waste recycling program to divert organic waste** generated by businesses, including multi-family residential dwellings with five or more units.

What Belongs in the Green ORGANICS/COMPOST Cart or Bin

Keep the stream clean! Proper sorting makes a difference!

FOOD SCRAPS All fresh, frozen, cooked or moldy food:

- Fruits & vegetables (including peels, pits & rinds)
- Bread, rice, pasta & other grains
- Dairy products
- Eggs & egg shells
- · Coffee grounds & tea leaves
- · Meat & bones

FOOD-SOILED PAPER

- Paper plates, cups, napkins & towels
- Coffee filters & paper tea bags
- Milk & juice cartons (not lined with foil)
- Paper bags & newspaper (used to contain/wrap food scraps)
- Paper takeout containers
- Pizza boxes (food-soiled)
- Wax paper & wax-coated boxes

PLANTS, YARD TRIMMINGS & CLEAN WOOD

- Flowers, plants, grass clippings, leaves & weeds
- Small branches (less than 6" in diameter and 3 feet in length)
- Clean dimensional lumber (less than 3 feet in length no paint, varnish, treatments, coatings or stains)
- Wooden chopsticks



Compostable, paper, or clear plastic bags permitted. No black or white plastic bags. A list of certified compostable bags can be found at: www.bpiworld.org.
