
## Recycling Conserves Water! Word Scramble

- Making paper from recycled fibers uses 49% less water than making paper from virgin fibers.
- Recycling one ton of paper Saves 7,000 gallons of water.
- Recycling one ton of **glass** requires 50% IESS water (12,000 **gallons**) than making glass from raw materials.
- Recycling **aluminum** creates 97% Iess water **pollution** than making new **metal** from ore.
- Recycling steel SOVES 40% of water used to make **steel** from ore.
- It takes 3-gallons of water to produce 1-gallon of **bottled** water.
