SENATE BILL 1383 California's Short-Lived Climate Pollutant Reduction Strategy

*California is requiring organic material (such as food scraps) be diverted away from landfills and surplus food be redirected to hungry people.
How can you comply?*



GREEN = ORGANICS

STARTING JANUARY 1, 2022:

- All residents and businesses in the City of San Ramon will need to have organic waste collection services. Contact ACI of San Ramon to sign up or improve your organics collection services today!
- Some businesses are required to donate surplus edible food to regional food rescue organizations. To find out if you are required to donate excess edible food, visit: www.CalRecycle.ca.gov/organics/slcp/foodrecovery/donors.
- Non-compliance will lead to fines and penalties.

REDUCING ORGANIC WASTE IN LANDFILLS = LESS METHANE.

Organics like food scraps, yard trimmings, paper, and cardboard make up half of what Californians dump in landfills. Organic waste in landfills emits methane, a climate super pollutant 84 times more potent than carbon dioxide.

Food Scraps and Food-Soiled Paper Belong in the Green Organics Containers

All food scraps and food-soiled paper belong in your green **Organics** cart or bin.

Remember to keep it clean and avoid contamination:

NØ Styrofoam®, Plastic, Glass, or Metal.



Compostable, paper, or clear plastic bags permitted.
