- A reduction in greenhouse gas emissions.

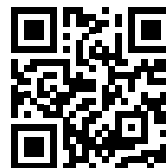


Avoid contamination and protect our sorting staff by properly sorting your waste. Make sure the items you place in your **Recyclables cart are recyclable.**

- Food scraps and food-soiled paper belong in your **ORGANICS** cart.
- Make sure recyclable plastic, metal, and glass food containers are empty and dry before placing them in the **RECYCLABLES** cart.

Reduce, Reuse, Rethink, & Recycle Before You Dispose

CHOOSE REUSABLES. Make it a habit to use travel mugs, reusable water bottles and shopping bags/totes.

BEFORE YOU REPLACE AN ITEM, SEE IF IT CAN BE REPAIRED. If you do purchase something new, find the highest quality/ longest lasting option possible.

OPT FOR USED PRODUCTS. Reuse what you already have, or purchase a "gently used" item from a resale/ thrift shop. Share/trade items with friends and neighbors, or browse reuse websites such as: FreeCycle.org or Resource.Stopwaste.org.

Sharps (*needles, scalpels, blades & lancets*) are hazardous waste and are NOT ALLOWED in any ACI of San Ramon collection container.

- Sharps may also be safely disposed of at the San Ramon Valley Fire District's Administrative Office, at 1500 Bollinger Canyon Rd., San Ramon. The drop box is outside the front door and is accessible 24/7.
