Proper Sorting is Essential

Keep Recyclables out of the Landfill!

KNOW WHERE TO THROW GARBAGE & ORGANICS DO NOT belong in the blue **RECYCLABLES** collection containers. For posters, guides, and more, please visit: www.sanramonrecycles.com/multi-family/resources/.

MAINTAIN A CLEAN STREAM!

Empty, wipe and/or rinse recyclable plastic, metal and glass food containers; and make sure recyclable paper is clean and dry before placing in the **RECYCLABLES** containers.

Sorting Tip - Keep an Eye on the Size!

Corrugated cardboard and paper boxes should be flattened and large pieces cut to 3' x 2' or smaller. Doing so:

- Allows for more room in the container.
- Prevents overflow and litter.
- Assures the pieces will fit in the hoppers of the collection vehicles.

The City of San Ramon's new commitment to encourage, educate, and reward its businesses and residents that take steps toward reducing dependency on single-use foodware.

TOGETHER, WE CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE!

By choosing reusable dishware over disposables wherever possible:

- Reduces the litter found on roadways and creek beds
- Avoids unnecessary trash that is normally sent to landfill (*most disposable foodware is not readily recyclable, nor does it add nourishment to compost*)
- Saves money on the purchase and disposal of single-use items
- Protects the San Francisco Bay and Pacific Ocean from pollutants.



EASY WAYS TO AVOID SINGLE-USE WASTE:

- Bring a cup/water bottle/travel mug to be refilled.
- Stow reusable utensils in your backpack or glove box.
- Pack reusable plates, cups, and napkins for a picnic.
- Plan ahead to sit down with friends and family for a pleasant dine-in experience at your favorite eatery.
