- A reduction in greenhouse gas emissions.

Small Sorting Actions That Make a HUGE Impact!

FLATTEN CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard and paper boxes should be flattened and large pieces cut to fit in the bin or cart. Doing so:

- Allows for more room in the container.
- · Prevents overflow and litter.



- Empty, wipe and/or rinse recyclable plastic, metal and glass food containers; and make sure recyclable paper is clean and dry.
- Keep RECYCLABLES loose (except for plastic bag-in-bag) inside your collection containers.



RECYCLABLES in bags (especially opaque/black ones) are sorted out as garbage and end up in the landfill.
