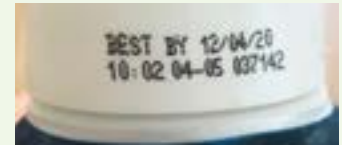
PROPER SORTING MAKES A DIFFERENCE!

Put your leftover food scraps and food-soiled paper in your **ORGANICS** cart.



Understanding Food Product Date Labels

Regardless of the printed date, always evaluate the quality of food prior to its consumption or disposal.



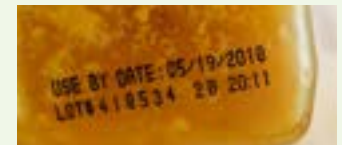
"BEST BY"

Indicates when a product will be of best flavor or quality. Not a purchase/safety date.



"SELL BY"

Tells the store how long to display the product for sale for inventory management. Not a safety date.



"USE BY"

Last date recommended for use of the product while at peak quality. Not a safety date **except when used on infant formula.**

Manage & Dispose of "FOG" Properly

Improper disposal of Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) will pollute the environment and clog your pipes and sewer/septic systems.

- For small amounts of FOG, scrape out or wipe and place in the green **Organics** cart.
- For large amounts of FOG, use the curbside cooking oil collection program! Residents may place used cooking oil (in sealed 1-gallon containers provided by ACI of San Ramon or the original sealed container) at the curb for collection each week. Contact us to request containers.
- For even LARGER amounts of FOG (large containers 5-gallons or less) such as from a turkey deep fryer, contact ACI of San Ramon to arrange collection.

DID YOU KNOW? Leftover household paint, stains, or sealants can be dropped off at participating PaintCare site locations at no charge. Some restrictions apply, please visit PaintCare.org for more information.
