Neighborhood Clean-Up Days

All single-family residential customers receive three (3) neighborhood clean-up days per year at no additional charge. Find your next scheduled neighborhood clean-up day at: www.sanramonrecycles.com/cleanup.

THE CLEAN-UP PROGRAM INCLUDES: Collection of up to 3 cubic yards (3' x 3' x 9') of materials and up to 2 large bulky items (*no single item over 200 lbs.*) per set out. This includes collection of clean undamaged reusable items that are set apart from other items. The reusable items will be sent to a sorting/donation facility.

Please note: no receipts are given for reusable items.

HELP US PROVIDE SAFE AND EFFICIENT SERVICE.

- Place items within 3 feet of the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled neighborhood clean-up day.
- Do not block the street or sidewalk.
- Do not set items out more than 24-hours in advance.
- A fee is charged when materials volume exceeds 3 cubic yards.
- Mark your reusable items with "REUSE".*



Use Your Handy Kitchen Pail and Organics Cart for Senate Bill 1383 Compliance!

SB 1383 is California's Short-Lived Climate Pollutant



Reduction Strategy.

Use your kitchen food scraps pail to store food scraps until you empty it into your **organics** cart. Please do not place the pail at the curb for collection. For more info about Senate Bill 1383, visit: www.sanramon.ca.gov/residential-organics.

You Can Reduce Water Pollution

Keep the creeks, rivers, the Delta, and the Bay clean and healthy.

Follow these tips:

- If you change your own oil, contain and recycle used oil and filters properly. ACI of San Ramon will collect contained used motor oil and filters. (see "Free Curbside Collection" on back)
- Prevent leaves in storm drains, place them in your green **organics** cart.

Free Curbside Collection

Household Batteries: In a zipper-lock style bag on top of (not inside) your **recyclables** cart. Please tape terminals on 9 volt batteries. *No automotive, lithium ion or nicad batteries allowed, these are treated as Hazardous Waste.*



Used Motor Oil & Cooking Oil:

In separate 1-gallon, or smaller, sealed screw-top containers (oils cannot be mixed). Place used oil filters in a sealed zipper-lock style bag. Place next to (not inside) your **recyclables** cart. Oil jugs and oil filter bags may be requested from ACI of San Ramon. *No other automotive liquids accepted.*

Have extra? Contain occasional extra recyclables in paper bags or cardboard boxes and place next to your **recyclables** cart for collection. Excess cardboard needs to be flattened, cut into pieces no larger than 2 ft by 3 ft, and stacked next to your **recyclables** cart.

Contact ACI of San Ramon to Purchase These Items:

EXTRA GARBAGE BAG TAGS are used for overflow garbage. Extra material will be collected when pre-paid tags are affixed to the trash bag(s). Call us to purchase tags or to arrange for additional service.



EXTRA YARD TRIMMINGS BAGS can be purchased and placed next to your **organics** cart on collection day. Yard trimmings set out in these bags will be composted. (*Only ACI of San Ramon bags are accepted. Contact us to purchase.*)



Maintain Smoke Detectors and Carbon Monoxide Alarms

- Test existing detectors and alarms.
- Install new batteries and properly recycle the old ones. (see "Free Curbside Collection" at left)
- Remove non-working detectors and alarms and install new ones.
- Dispose of non-working detectors and alarms responsibly.



Many manufacturers offer a mail-in program for smoke detectors and alarms. Refer to the product label, user's manual, or warranty for manufacturer's instructions.
