## FOOD SCRAPS

All fresh, frozen, cooked or moldy food:

- Fruits & vegetables (including peels, pits, & rinds)
- Bread, rice, pasta, & other grains
- Dairy products
- Eggs & egg shells
- Coffee grounds & tea leaves
- Meat & bones

## FOOD-SOILED PAPER

- Paper plates, cups, napkins, & towels
- Coffee filters & paper tea bags
- Paper bags & newspaper (used to contain/wrap food scraps)
- Paper takeout containers
- Pizza boxes (food-soiled)
- Shredded paper (no plastic)
- Wax paper & wax-coated boxes

## PLANTS, YARD TRIMMINGS & CLEAN WOOD

- Flowers, plants, grass clippings, leaves, & weeds
- Small branches (less than 6" in diameter and 3 feet in length)
- Clean dimensional lumber (less than 3 feet in length - no paint, varnish, treatments, coatings, or stains)
- Wooden chopsticks



Compostable, paper, or clear plastic bags permitted.
