Does Your Complex Have the Right Levels of Collection Service?

KEEP IT CLEAN & LOOSE

- Empty, wipe and/or rinse recyclable plastic, metal and glass food containers; and make sure recyclable paper is clean and dry.
- Keep **RECYCLABLES** loose (except for the plastic bag-in-bag program) inside your blue bins.



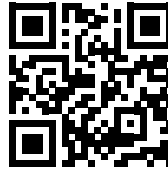
DID YOU KNOW?
