ONE CUBIC FOOT BAG OF COMPOST

One bag per vehicle while supplies last.



FREE DROP OFF OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS (UP TO THREE CUBIC YARDS PER HOUSEHOLD):

• **CLOTHING:** Must be clean and dry. No rugs or pillows.



• **RECYCLABLES:** Cardboard (flattened), paper, bottles, and cans.



• **REUSABLE ITEMS:** Unbroken and in good condition. No single items over 200 lbs. Please contain multiple small items in a bag or box.



• **SCRAP METAL:** Single pieces up to 200 lbs. No refrigerators, AC units, propane/helium tanks, or items containing freon, oil, or gas.



• **ELECTRONICS:** No single items over 200 lbs. Please contain multiple small items in a bag or box. Please indicate if items are operational or not.

• **YARD TRIMMINGS & CLEAN WOOD:** Branches, prunings, leaves, plants. No paint, varnish, coatings, treatments or stains. The material must fit in the dumpster.



• **SHREDDING SERVICES:** Two banker boxes per customer.



PLEASE REMEMBER: ONLY THE ITEMS LISTED ABOVE WILL BE ACCEPTED. KEEP ITEMS SEPARATE. THERE WILL BE CONTAINERS FOR EACH TYPE OF ITEM.

NO GARBAGE, STYROFOAM®, DIRT, BRICK, CONCRETE, SHEETROCK, PRESSURIZED TANKS, TIRES, OR SINGLE ITEMS OVER 200 LBS.

NO NEEDLES/SHARPS, PAINT, MOTOR OIL, BATTERIES, FLUORESCENT TUBES, CHEMICALS, OR HAZARDOUS WASTE.

Senate Bill (SB) 1383 California's Short-Lived Climate Pollutant Reduction Strategy



California has implemented statewide organic waste recycling and surplus food recovery.

All jurisdictions must provide organic waste collection services to all residents and businesses and recycle these organic materials.

Reducing organic waste in landfills = less methane.

Organics like food scraps, yard trimmings, paper, and cardboard make up half of what Californians dump in landfills. Organic waste in landfills emits methane, a climate super pollutant more than 80 times more potent than carbon dioxide.

Do your part. Keep the green stream clean.

Only items that were once alive belong the organics collection containers. The material is taken to a facility to create compost.



Proper sorting makes a difference.

Food scraps and food-soiled paper belong in your **ORGANICS** containers. Plastic, metal, and glass do **NOT** belong in the **ORGANICS** containers. You can find more tips at:
