The Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance (MWELO)

A statewide water conservation law for new and renovated landscapes.

The ordinance regulates water usage in new and renovated

landscapes. It imposes restrictions on high water-consuming plants and irrigation systems while promoting a comprehensive approach to landscaping that integrates alternative water sources such as gray water, harvested rainwater, and recycled water.

Who needs to comply?

Any single-family or multi-family residential, public, institutional, or commercial project that requires a permit, plan review, or check from the local review agency **AND** meets one of these size thresholds needs to comply:

- New construction project with a total landscape area* greater than 500 sq. ft.
- Rehabilitation of existing landscape with a total landscape area* greater than 2,500 sq. ft.

service for recyclables, organics, and garbage.
