Manage Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) at Your Complex

Maintain Smoke Detectors & Carbon Monoxide Alarms

- Test existing detectors/alarms.
- Remove non-working detectors/alarms and install new ones.
- Install new batteries (if applicable). Properly recycle used batteries.
- Dispose of non-working detectors/alarms responsibly.
 Many manufacturers offer a mail-in program for smoke detectors/alarms. Refer to the product label, user's manual, or warranty for manufacturer's instructions.

Please Remember NØ Sharps!

"Sharps" is a medical term for devices with sharp points or edges that can puncture or cut skin such as needles, syringes, lancets, auto injectors (such as EpiPens), and infusion sets.

- Ask your pharmacist about available disposal options.
- Sharps and pharmaceuticals may be disposed of at the San Ramon Safety Complex at 2401 Crow Canyon Rd. The SHARPS-BOX is located in the lobby next to the pharmaceutical kiosk. For instructions on how to prepare you sharps and pharmaceuticals for disposal visit CityofSanRamon.info/SharpsDisposal Pharmaceuticals and sharps are only accepted for disposal during business hours, please DO NOT leave medication or needles outside the Police Department's front door when the business office is closed.

Use the Clean Harbors HHW door-to-door (D2D) collection service at no additional cost!



- The property manager/owner must make an appointment on the tenants' behalf. (*Tenants cannot make appointments on their own.*)
- The property manager will work with Clean Harbors staff to designate an area to collect HHW at the complex.

You Can Minimize Water Pollution

Keep the creeks, rivers, the Delta, and the Bay clean and healthy. Follow these tips:

- If your tenants change their own oil, remind them to properly contain and recycle used oil and filters.
- Check parking areas for fluid leaks. If a car is leaking, have the owner use a drip pan and arrange repair.
- Place litter in the correct collection container and make sure the lid is fully closed.
- Prevent leaves from getting into storm drains and place them in your green organics container(s).
- Avoid applying fertilizers and pesticides, especially if rain is forecasted.

California Regulations Require Recycling & Composting*

California Senate Bill 1383 requires that multi-family residences MUST SORT RECYCLABLES & ORGANIC MATERIAL OUT OF THE GARBAGE and subscribe to adequate levels of service for recyclables, organics, and garbage. Each multi-family complex in San Ramon has been provided with Recyclables and

The ACI of San Ramon Sustainability Specialists are available to visit your complex to conduct waste assessments, make service suggestions, help train and give presentations to employees and tenants, and provide materials to assist your tenants with proper sorting and waste reduction.

- The Recycling Tote is to transport recyclables to the blue recycling collection containers at your complex.
