Compost organic waste, such as food scraps and yard waste to make nutrient-rich compost, a superfood for plants you can use in your yard/garden.

THINGS YOU CAN COMPOST AT HOME:

- Fruit & vegetable scraps
- Tree & shrub trimmings
- Fruit tree & vegetable plant waste
- Lawn clippings
- Leaves
- Coffee grounds

Do not compost meat, dairy, or a lot of baked goods in your home compost pile to avoid pests and odors.

State Law Mandates Proper Sorting

The graphics on the carts and bins and our proper sorting outreach materials are a **state-mandated requirement per California Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383)**. Even the frequency with which we inform residents that recycling and organics participation is mandatory is dictated by SB 1383. For those of you still uncertain about what goes where, we hope you find our image-based, color-coded carts with QR codes on the container labels that send you to our website, **helpful**. Sort Your Waste Correctly

Make sure everyone in your household knows what material goes in which cart.



Loose, empty, and dry recyclable plastic, metal, and glass food containers belong in the **RECYCLABLES** cart.*



Food scraps and food-soiled paper belong in your **ORGANICS** cart. No glass, no metal, no plastic.



Styrofoam®, plastic wrap, and non-recyclable packaging belong in your **GARBAGE** cart.

***REMEMBER:** Multiple plastic bags placed in one bag and tied shut can be put into the recyclables cart.
